Affidavit of Raj Kumar-complainant filed in Court today is
taken on record.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of
the Code of Criminal Procedure for setting aside/quashing the
complaint case No. 371-1-09 dated 06.02.2008 (Annexure P-3),
summoning order dated 02.12.2003 (Annexure P-4) as well as DDR
No.35, dated 18.10.2007 (Annexure P-2), on the basis of
compromise (Annexure P-5).

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate has been received,

in which, it has been categorically observed that compromise was effected between the parties without any pressure or coercion. The same is genuine one. Even otherwise, matter involved in these proceedings is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

So, in view of circumstances narrated above as well as the observations made in case reported as **Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another; 2012(4) RCR(Criminal) 543**, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for the benefit of the parties and would certainly bring peace and harmony between them.

Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and complaint case No. 371-1-09 dated 06.02.2008 (Annexure P-3), summoning order dated 02.12.2003 (Annexure P-4) as well as DDR No.35, dated 18.10.2007 (Annexure P-2) are quashed qua the petitioners.
