This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.129 dated 04.08.2015 registered under Sections 381, 427, 120-B IPC at Police Station Dehlon, District Ludhiana.

After arguing for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not wish to press this petition on merits but the petitioner would surrender before the Court and move an application for regular bail and a direction may be issued to the Court to decide the said application expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair request. Let the petitioner surrender before the Court on 15.09.2015 and move an application for regular bail

which shall be decided expeditiously by the Court but in any case within 3 days on merits. It is made clear that in case the petitioner does not surrender before the Court in the aforesaid manner the present petition would be deemed to have been dismissed.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
