JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.231 dated 18.12.2014, under Sections 18, 25 of the NDPS Act (Sections 61 & 85 of NDPS Act added later on), registered with Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana (**Annexure P-1**).

As per the allegations in the FIR, three accused persons namely Amarjit Singh, Sandeep Kaur and mother-Parkash Kaur were apprehended and a recovery of 9 Kgs. of Opium was recovered from them. The name of the petitioner is alleged to have surfaced in the investigations as accused-Amarjit in his disclosure statement naming the petitioner as one of the four purchasers of Opium from him.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner contends that a false case has been foisted and no case whatsoever is pending against the petitioner. He further submits that in compliance of order dated 10.09.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from A.S.I. Jasbir Singh, does not controvert the aforesaid factual position.

In view of the above, interim order dated 10.09.2015, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
