Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 8, as the petitioners have got married against the wishes of the said respondents.

This Court vide order dated 06.09.2014 granted liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar for protection, as per the instructions dated 10.08.2010 issued by the Home Department, Punjab, who shall look into the representation dated 01.09.2014.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable-Manohar Lal, has informed this Court that the petitioners,

namely, Vandana and Ran Vijay Singh, have made a joint statement before the police showing their willingness that they do not need any protection.

In view of the aforesaid peculiar facts, no further order is required to be passed in this case.
