LISA GILL, J.

While referring to para 2 of affidavit dated 01.12.2014 of the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, he was directed to be present in Court.

Pursuant to order dated 22.12.2014, Mr. Yurinder Singh, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar is present in Court today.

While admitting the lapse pointed out he tenders an unconditional apology and submits that mention of the next date of hearing as 29.11.2014 on 01.12.2014 is due to an inadvertent mistake.

It is assured by the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar that in future in all cases where official witnesses are to be examined, necessary directions shall be issued to ensure their presence in Court on the date fixed before the trial Court so that the trial is not delayed on account of their absence.

Apology tendered by the Commission of Police, Jalandhar is accepted and it is assumed that necessary steps shall be taken to implement the assurance given in Court.

It is further apprised that in the instant case all the prosecution witnesses have been examined and the matter is fixed before the trial Court on 17.01.2015 for recording the statement of the accused under Section 313 Cr.P.C.

In view of the advanced stage of the trial, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
