JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner in the case FIR No.63 dated 30.04.2015 under Sections 307, 323, 148, 149 and 120-B, IPC and Sections 25, 54 and 59 of the Arms Act, registered with Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

As per the allegations made by the complainant-Sham Lal, the petitioner-Kuljeet Singh @ Jeet along with another co-accused dragged Sham Lal while main accused-Jagbir Singh fired a shot from his pistol which struck the complainant.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegations are false as no sane person would fire a shot when his alleged accomplices are dragging the injured-Sham Lal.

Be that as it may, the petitioner has joined the investigation and no recovery is to be effected from him.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from HC Kashmir Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, interim anticipatory bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 10.09.2015, is made absolute.
