Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.95 dated 25.7.2015 under Section 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 10.9.2015, whereby the petitioner was granted interim bail to the

satisfaction of the arresting officer, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Sanjiv Kumar, also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 10.9.2015 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
