Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondents no.2 and 3 to submit final report to the concerned Court in case FIR No.470 dated 29.10.2010 u/s 186/353/506/34 IPC and 68-C of Police Act registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Distt. Amritsar (Annexure P1).

At this stage, it will be relevant to reproduce the operative part of the status report filed by way of affidavit of Harjit Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, North, Amritsar, on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3, which reads as under:-

“That it is further submitted that since the challan of the instant case against the accused-petitioner has been presented in the Court and the offences u/s 353/186 Cr.P.C. are non-compoundable, as described in Section 320 Cr.P.C., therefore, the petitioners are not competent to the relief sought in the petition, rather are liable to face the trial in the learned trial Court and the present petition is liable to be dismissed on these grounds alone.”

In view of the aforesaid, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of accordingly.
