The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 154 dated 20.12.2014 registered at Police Station Maqboolpura, District Amritsar under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914.

The petitioner was asked to join the investigation vide order dated 29.01.2015. The petitioner has joined the investigation but had not cooperated.

Learned State counsel submits that they have to find out the source of the illicit liquor.

Learned counsel for the petitioner had urged that two FIRs were registered and same amount of liquor was shown in both the FIRs.

Copies of the FIRs are available on record. The recovery is from different vehicles at different times. The petitioner has not cooperated during the investigation. Recovery has been effected from the petitioner from the car owned by him.

In view of the above, no case for anticipatory bail is made out. The petition is dismissed.
