The present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.), has been filed seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.98 dated 20.8.2015, registered under Section 61/1/14 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, at Police Station Sadar Distt. Sri Muktsar Sahib Punjab.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 10.9.2015, the petitioner has joined investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

The learned State counsel further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated

10.9.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in
Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
