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**JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)**

The prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.100 dated 06.03.2015, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 302 of IPC and Section 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered with Police Station Indri, District Karnal.

As per the allegations in the FIR, there was a previous quarrel between the brother of the complainant-Rahul, namely, Rohit with accused Naveen, Ankit and Rana, which led to three accused to take a group of 16/17 friends to the house of Rohit on the day of Holi on 06.03.2015 at about 3:50 PM. The main accused-Ankit is alleged to have put a country-made pistol on the head of said Rohit and while saving him, his father-Raj Kumar was inflicted fatal knife blows by Naveen on his chest while Rana and Satish had caught hold of the deceased.

The name of the petitioner has surfaced during investigation, except the disclosure statement of the main accused-Ankit, stating the fact of the petitioner-

Anuj accompanying them to the house of the deceased, there is neither any other evidence nor any role attributed.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 15.03.2015.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar, states that the investigation is over and the challan has been presented. He further submits that no other case is pending against the present petitioner.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period and the facts of the case as noticed above, this Court finds that petitioner/accused-Anuj deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Karnal.
