Petitioners prayer is for adequate protection as they apprehend danger at the hands of their daughter respondent no.3 and son-in-law respondent no.4.

The petition has been pending since 2014 and the petitioners have not complained of any incident subsequent thereto indicating that apprehension may be without any basis.

Be that as it may, this Court would not like to comment on this aspect any further but suffice it to say that in case respondent no.3 and 4 have threatened the petitioners or actually indulged in violence they would still have a remedy to approach the Court of Magistrate under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C.
