ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 52 dated 25.07.2015, registered under Section 61/1/14 of Excise Act, Police Station Fatehgarh Churian, Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that three separate FIRs were registered against the petitioner & his two brothers and they are residing in the same house and the cases are being registered as he belongs to an opposite party. Learned counsel further submits that interim bail has been allowed to his brothers.

The State counsel informs that the bail applications filed by the brothers of the petitioner are still pending and there are five more FIRs against the petitioner and the petitioner is involved in illicit liquor which is being supplied in the nearby villages and custodial interrogation is necessary.

There are several FIRs against the petitioner and the allegations against the petitioner are that illicit liquor is being prepared. No case for anticipatory bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
