Prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.PC to the petitioner-Amandeep Kumar in case FIR No.81 dated 20.05.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 379-B IPC and 411 of the Indian Penal Code added later on registered with Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar.

As per the allegations, on the day of occurrence i.e. on 20.05.2015, petitioner along with two other co-accused namely Sukhpal @ Mani & Davinder Kumar came on a motor cycle and snatched a mobile phone from the complainant and fled away from the spot.

Petitioner is stated to be in custody since 22.05.2015 and remaining two co-accused have since been granted regular bail vide order dated 1.9.2015. He further states that even a compromise has been effected

between the parties on 19.9.2015 and accordingly the petition has been filed seeking quashing of the FIR.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Baldev Singh does not controvert the fact that two other co-accused have since been granted regular bail.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, keeping in view the parity of treatment, no useful purpose is going to be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars. As such the present petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Jalandhar.
