Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.189 dated 02.10.2010 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order passed by this Court, petitioner appeared before the learned Court of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phillaur and order dated 02.02.2015 was passed. In these circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that instant petition deserves to be allowed.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Vijay Kumar, Police Station Phillaur, submits that petitioner has appeared before the trial Court as it was a matter of record. He further submits that the challan has already been presented only against the

petitioner, he being the husband and his parents have been declared innocent by the investigating agency.

In view of the above, order dated 29.01.2015 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute keeping in view the order dated 02.02.2015 passed by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phillaur. Petitioner has complied with the order passed by this Court. He shall face the trial.

With the abovesaid observations made, present petition stands allowed.
