This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a case FIR No.135 dated 28.08.2014 under Sections 304/34 IPC (during investigation offence under Sections 341, 302 IPC has been deleted and challan has been filed under Sections 304/34 IPC on 04.12.2014), registered at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga.

Counsel for the State on instructions from Head Constable Sikander Singh has informed this Court that the role attributed to the present petitioner is a lalkara as per the allegations set out in the FIR. The petitioner has joined the investigation on 04.02.2015 and no recovery is to be affected and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the said fact, the order dated 02.02.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute till the presentation of the

challan and thereafter the petitioner shall furnish fresh bail/surety bonds before the Magistrate, which shall be accepted by the Magistrate to its satisfaction.

Disposed of accordingly.
