Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, Jaswant Singh, who has been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Section 384 IPC, in a case arising out of FIR No. 197, dated 22.08.2013, registered at Police Station, City, Kapurthala, District-Kapurthala

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Head Constable-Balkar Singh, very fairly states that in compliance of the interim directions issued by this Court, vide order dated 26.03.2015, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 26.03.2015, are made absolute.

However, petitioner shall join investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
