RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks directions to the respondent authorities to ensure that life and liberty of the petitioner is not put to danger at the instance of respondent No.5.

Notice of motion was issued and Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali) was directed to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioner is not put to any harm or threat at the hands of private respondent No.5. Inspector General of Police, Patiala was also directed to get conducted an inquiry into the matter.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurnam Singh, Police Station Sadar Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Mohali), submits that in compliance of the order passed by this Court, a detailed inquiry was conducted by Superintendent of Police (Detective), SAS Nagar (Mohali) on

the directions issued to him by the Inspector General of Police, Patiala. She further submits that after conducting the detailed inquiry, report has already been submitted, which is Annexure R-2 with the reply filed by way of affidavit dated 29.01.2015. She further submits that in view of the above, no further orders are called for and the present petition may be disposed of having been rendered infructuous.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner also fairly states that let the present petition be disposed of in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State but appropriate directions may be issued to the respondent authorities to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioner, at the hands of respondent No.5.

In view of the abovesaid respective stands taken by learned counsel for the parties, present petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali)-respondent No.2 to ensure that since the petitioner is widow and a senior citizen, he shall ensure that no harm is caused to her life and liberty, at the hands of respondent No.5 or anybody at his instance.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
