This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant
of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.203 dated 23.11.2000
registered under Section 302 IPC, at Police Station Lopoke, District
Amritsar(Rural).

After arguing for some time, the learned counsel for the
petitioner states that he does not wish to press this petition on merits but

liberty may be granted to the petitioners to surrender before the trial Court and move an application for regular bail and they should be granted protection till such time as they surrender and the trial Court be directed to decide the said application expeditiously since the petitioners were found innocent by the police and have now been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C..

I find this to be a fair request.

Resultantly this petition is dismissed and the petitioners are granted time to surrender before the trial Court till 16.10.2015, till which time their arrest shall remain stayed. In the event of their surrendering before the trial Court and moving application for regular bail, the trial Court shall decide the same expeditiously but in any case within three days. It is made clear that in case the petitioners do not surrender before the Court in the aforesaid manner the present petition would be deemed to have been dismissed.

Petition stands dismissed as having been not pressed.
