Petitioner seeks concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered at the instance of Rattan Singh alleging that his son Narinder having been insulted by the petitioner and his wife on account of non-payment of wages and having been thrown out of the shop, felt humiliated and committed suicide.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has vehemently contended that the allegations against the petitioner are vague and that the story of the prosecution regarding abetment of suicide is apparently concoction.

After going through the record and considering the nature of the allegations against the petitioner, no ground is made out to grant the concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Application of pre-arrest bail is dismissed without prejudice to the right of the petitioner to seek concession of regular bail by surrendering before the Illaqa Magistrate or the investigating officer.
