The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for quashing of FIR No.122 dated 27.06.2010, registered under Section 420, 465, 447, 506, 511 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Beas, Distt. Amritsar, and all consequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise, Annexure P-2.

Heard.

It is specifically averred in para No.5 of the petition that none of the petitioners is a proclaimed offender till date, whereas, learned State counsel, on instructions, informs that petitioner Nos.3, 4

and 7 were declared proclaimed offenders. Whereas, as per the report prepared by the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Baba Bakala Sahib, out of ten accused, only five came forward to record their statements. It is further informed that Lovepreet Singh and Lakha Singh have been declared proclaimed offenders.

As the assertion made by learned counsel for the petitioners on oath and at Bar is found to be lacking in veracity, no case for quashing the FIR is made out.

Dismissed with cost of Rs.25,000/-, to be paid to the State as litigation expenses.
