The instant petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.88 dated 10.7.2005, registered under Sections 304-A, 337, 338, 379 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sadar, Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced a certified copy of the order, which is taken on record. He submits that the petitioner in compliance with the order dated 28.10.2014 has furnished the bail bonds and has been released on interim bail by the learned trial Court. He has also deposited a sum of Rs.25,000/- as directed by this Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 28.10.2014 is made absolute.
