Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.27 dated 01.06.2015, under Sections 326, 341, 323, 324, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Hajipur, District Hoshiarpur.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 14.09.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the parties have amicably settled their dispute.

Mr.Avtar Singh Bhatti, Advocate has appeared on behalf of complainant-respondent No.2 and has admitted the factum of compromise between the parties.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 14.09.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
