This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail to petitioner in a case registered against her vide FIR No.361 dated 11.08.2014 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Sector 5, Panchkula.

At the time of issuance of notice of motion, petitioner was asked to join investigation. Thereafter, investigation was transferred to Crime Branch. However, it was taken up again by the Panchkula Police and SIT was constituted.

Learned State counsel submits that petitioner appeared before the investigating agency on 23.11.2015. Her specimen signatures and writing has been taken and for seeking opinion of FSL, Madhuban. He further submits that investigation shall be completed expeditiously and final report shall be submitted.

Mr. Dhir, on instructions from Parmod Kumar, ACP (Crime), Head of SIT, submits that pursuant to order dated 10.09.2014, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 10.09.2014 is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed in aforesaid terms.
