Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of Complaint No. COMA/105/2015, dated 24.12.2014, titled as “*Munish Awasthi Vs. District Forest Officer*” under Sections 29, 30, 32, 33 and 63 of Indian Forest Act, 1927 (Annexure P-1) and summoning order dated 24.12.2014 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhaina(Annexure P-5), whereby the petitioner has been summoned to face trial.

The order of summoning dated 24.12.2014 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhaina for which, there is remedy available under the law.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition and wishes to the withdraw the same with liberty to avail alternative remedy of revision.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to raise all pleas, as available to him under the law before the Revisionary Court.
