AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for regular bail in case bearing FIR No. 77 dated 28.05.2014, under Section 15/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Kot Ise Khan, District Moga.

Custody certificate by way of affidavit of Iqbal Singh Brar, Superintendent, Sub Jail, Moga has been filed. Taken on record. As per the custody certificate the petitioner has been in custody for the last 7 months and 5 days.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon order dated 20.05.2013 passed in CRM-M No. 12299 of 2013 as per which there was a recovery of 60 kilograms of poppy husk and bail was granted in view of the quantity after a period of 7 months. As per learned counsel in the

present case the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Keeping in mind the above facts I deem it appropriate to grant bail to the petitioner to the satisfaction of the trial Court. Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands disposed of.
