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**JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)**

The petitioner sought directions for protecting his life and liberty as he is threatened by respondent no.4 to enter into a compromise, in an FIR No.346 dated 11.06.2015 (Annexure P-1) registered for abduction of petitioner. The allegations in the FIR would reveal that after wedding ceremony petitioner along with his friend were bringing the newly wedded couple in the vehicle. Allegedly, respondent no.4 stopped and forcibly took away petitioner, with the help of his companions i.e. 2-3 more boys. The FIR in question was registered at the instance of Dinesh Kumar who happened to be friend of petitioner.

The petitioner was never harmed on the day when he was allegedly, forcibly taken away, resultantly, there does not exist any apprehension or threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner as on today. It may be correct that the police has registered the FIR, but it is always not

necessary, that in each and every case the police has to make the arrest. The pleadings in the petition are repeatedly aimed towards inaction of the police in arresting the accused persons.

After registration of the case investigation is purely the domain of the police and normally there should not be any interference, unless and until the investigation is not being done properly, fairly and in a transparent manner. The allegations in the FIR do not disclose any motive, much less any previous enmity with any one, therefore, the FIR version cannot be believed, before investigation. There is no such ground and therefore, this Court is not inclined to interfere by issuing of any direction, as prayed for.

Thus, in my considered opinion there is no further action called for.

Dismissed.
