REKHA MITTAL, J.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has already joined investigation in compliance with interim bail granted by the Court on September 24, 2014 and he is ready to face proceedings in accordance with law.

Counsel for the complainant has submitted that the complainant has been deprived of property left behind by her father Ajit Singh, who died in the year 2013 due to heart attack. It is further submitted that keeping in view the gravity of allegations against the petitioner, he does not deserve concession of pre-arrest bail.

Counsel for the State has conceded to factual assertion that the petitioner has already joined investigation and states that his custodial

interrogation is not required.

Keeping in view the above, the interim bail granted to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
