District Khanna. Further prayer has been made that the petitioner be not called to Police Station without issuing notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C.

On the last date of hearing, learned State counsel has stated that cancellation report has been prepared and it is pending for approval from the Senior Superintendent of Police.

Needful shall be done by the Senior Superintendent of Police within one month from today. In case, no action is taken then the petitioner will be at liberty to file a fresh petition. If the petitioner is required, then he shall be called through notice under Section 160 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
