Report dated 28.09.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Chandigarh has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Preet Kaur Maan as well as of complainant Dilbagh Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052,** FIR No.413 dated 02.10.2014 under Sections 453,506 IPC, Police Station, Sector 39, Chandigarh and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.
