1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?
2. To be referred to the Reporters or not?
3. Whether the judgment should be reported in the Digest?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

At the very outset, learned counsel states that in the array of parties the name of respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, District Hoshiarpur, Punjab has inadvertently been mentioned as Superintendent of Police and prays that the same may be correct.

Allowed as prayed for. Registry is directed to make necessary corrections in the memo of parties.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their

parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of School Leaving Certificate (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 01.09.1992 whereas petitioner No.2 has placed on record a copy of Certificate of Punjab School Education Board (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 28.12.1991. They have also moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, Punjab (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Hoshiarpur, Punjab to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
