The petitioners had allegedly made an attempt to play fraud upon the Court by producing forged revenue record with an objective to help the accused to obtain bail.

Report received indicates that no compromise was produced before the Court. I am of the opinion that in the peculiar circumstances of this case where a fraud has been played with the Court, the parties cannot in any manner compromise the matter. It will always be open to the trial Court to consider the facts and circumstances of the case but quashing on the basis of compromise does not appear to be appropriate.

Dismissed without prejudice to the right of the petitioners to avail any other legal remedy available to them.
