Report dated 05.10.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class Abohar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Parveen Singh as well as of complainant Jaskaran @ Kalu and Vinod Kumar it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the offence is not heinous in nature and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.143 dated 13.08.2014 under Sections 457,380,511 IPC Police Station, Bahaw Wala Tehsil Abohar, District Fazilka and all other consequential proceedings

arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.

Petition stands disposed off.
