Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.102 dated 02.06.2012, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 326, 427, 452, 506, 307, 302 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Kurukshetra University Kurukshetra, District Kurukshetra.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 15.09.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that it is a case of version and cross version. Petitioners are not attributed any injury on the person of the deceased or the injured. Petitioners are regularly appearing before the Trial Court as the challan was presented in the Court in the year 2012. Now offence under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 has

been added.

Notice of motion for 02.11.2015.

In the meantime, petitioners are directed to surrender before the Trial Court and the Trial Court shall release the petitioners on interim bail subject to its satisfaction."

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in pursuance to the above order, petitioners have surrendered before the trial Court and have furnished the necessary bail bonds.

Accordingly, the interim bail furnished by the petitioners, before the trial Court, in pursuance to the order dated 15.09.2015 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
