The petitioner has applied for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.37 dated 24.05.2014 under Section 21/61/85 of NDPS Act, Police Station Fatehgarh Panjtoor, District Moga.

As per allegations of the prosecution, 252 grams of Heroin and Rs.1,07,000/- were recovered from the petitioner and one Gurwinder Singh from a Scorpio vehicle on secret information. Recovered Heroin was weighed along with the polythene bag. Otherwise also the Heroin recovered is slightly above then the non-commercial quantity. The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 24.05.2014. This Court in authority **Gurpreet Singh Vs. State of Punjab (P&H) 2014(2) 1052** allowed the concession of bail where the quantity recovered was marginally higher than the commercial quantity.

So, without commenting on the merits of the case the petition stands accepted, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
