The prayer is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in Case FIR No.97 dated 26.05.2015, under Sections 307, 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Division No.7, Ludhiana **(Annexure P-1)**.

As per allegations in the FIR, the petitioner had accompanied his leader-Rajiv Kumar on attack on the complainant-Davinder Singh @ Binda. He is stated to have armed with *knife/Sua* and inflicted a blow on the fingers of the left hand of the complainant.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Mohan Lal, submits that Rajiv Kumar and his gang of friends use to collect *Gunda tax* from the auto rickshaw drivers and on refusal of payment of such tax at the rate of Rs. 10/- per trip by the father of the complainant, the gang armed with deadly weapons attacked the complainant and inflicted thirteen injuries on his person including one on the head, which is opined to be grievous in nature.

Keeping in view the gravity of offence, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
