JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.111 dated 05.09.2012, under Sections 395/489 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered with Police Station Kotwali Nabha, District Patiala (**Annexure P-1**) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 31.08.2015 (**Annexure P-4**) arrived at between the parties.

As per the prosecution case, the names of the petitioners/accused have surfaced in the investigation regarding taking away a bag containing gold ornaments weighing 500 grams from the Car of the complainant.

Although a report from the learned trial Court has been received regarding the genuineness of the compromise between the parties pursuant to a interim order passed by this Court on 15.09.2015, keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence, this Court is not inclined to entertain quashing of a non-compoundable offence of such serious culpability.

At this stage, learned Counsel for the petitioners/accused prays for permission to withdraw the present petition.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
