Petitioner can be granted the concession of bail on the following grounds:

- (1) He was not named in the FIR;
- (2) No specific role has been attributed to him, he was involved on the basis of disclosure statement of main accused Rohtas;
- (3) Accused Rohtas has been granted concession of regular bail; and
- (4) Four prosecution material witnesses regarding the occurrence have turned hostile and not supported the case of the prosecution.

In view of said circumstances, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
