The appellant has filed claim petition on account of death of Chhotu Ram alleging himself as adopted son. It has been written in the finding that the appellant has failed to prove his adoption.

This Court vide order dated 14.01.2014 allowed the claimant to produce on record the document by way of additional evidence from which his adoption can be proved. In spite of that, case was adjourned several time but till date no such document was placed on record.

In these circumstances, this Court is left with no option except to dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution because no one has appeared on behalf of the appellant.

So, the appeal stands dismissed for want of prosecution.
