AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This order shall disposed of above mentioned four petitions filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner(s) in case F.I.R. No.02 dated 01.04.2010 registered under Sections 323/324/307/452/450/148/149 IPC at Police Station Airport Rajasansi, District Amritsar as the same have arisen out of the same FIR. For the sake of convenience the facts are being taken from CRM-M-31356-2015.

On 15.09.2015 the following order was passed in CRM-31356-2015 :-

“Learned counsel relies upon the order dated 27.08.2015 passed in CRM-M-26135-2015 titled as Sukhbir Singh v. State of Punjab to contend that similarly situated co-accused was granted the concession of bail.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ashish Sanghi, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to supply a copy of the petition to the learned DAG during the course of the day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further undertakes to serve the respondent No.2 by way of dasti process. May do so.

Dasti only.

Adjourned to 22.09.2015.”

On 28.09.2015 the following order was passed :-

“Learned counsel for respondent No.2 seeks a short adjournment.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has no objection to grant of stay but in the meantime, interim relief be granted to the petitioner.

Adjourned to 20.11.2015.

In the meantime, the petitioners shall appear before the trial court and on their doing so, they shall be released on interim bail on their furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial court.

A photo stat copy of this order be placed on the file of connected case.”

Service is complete but none has entered appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 to oppose the petition.

Learned Additional Advocate General has accepted these factual assertions.

All the four petitions are allowed in in terms of the order dated 27.08.2015 passed in CRM-M-26135-2015 titled as **“Sukhbir Singh Vs. State of Punjab”**.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
