AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.343 dated 16.08.2015 registered under Sections 332/353/186/506 IPC at Police Station SGM Nagar, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that similarly situated co-accused was granted the concession of anticipatory bail by order dated 15.09.2015 passed in CRM-M-29931 of 2015.

Learned Assistant Advocate General has accepted this fact.

In the circumstances, I find no reason to distinguish the case of the petitioners to that of co-accused.

In view of the entire facts and circumstances of the present case, and without commenting upon the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Resultantly, this petition is allowed and it is directed that in the event of their arrest, the petitioners shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
