1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?
2. To be referred to the Reporters or not?
3. Whether the judgment should be reported in the Digest?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for a direction to the official respondents to transfer the enquiry to some adjoining District or to some senior police official or to some independent agency for free and fair investigation.

Learned counsel has argued that no action has been taken till date on a report lodged by him. Learned counsel has further argued that in this connection the petitioner has also moved representation dated 19.06.2015 (Annexure P-3) to the respondent No.3-S.S.P., Ferozepur and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.3 to

look into the matter and decide his representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.3-the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur is directed to look into the matter/representation (Annexure P-3) and take whatever action he deems necessary as per law. .

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
