This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.496 dated 14.11.2014 registered under Sections 498-A, 307,304-B read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station Kharkhoda, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that charges under Section 306/302 IPC were framed. The other co-accused of the petitioner i.e. husband and mother-in-law of deceased Anita are behind the bars. The petitioner is in custody for the last more than one year. The trial is still going on. The only allegation against the present petitioner is that he demanded one gold ring. There is nobody to look after the family affairs as husband of the deceased is already behind the bars. All material witnesses have been examined

and there is no chance to influence the remaining witnesses.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State has not disputed the custody period as well as the allegations levelled against the petitioner.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and also the fact that the petitioner is behind the bars for the last more than one year; all material witnesses have been examined and main accused i.e. husband of the deceased is behind the bars, no useful purpose would be served by keeping him in custody, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Ram Chander is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
