Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in Complaint No.170 dated 11.07.2009 titled as “Binder Singh versus Jugraj Singh and others”, under Sections 3/4 (x) (i) of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities Act), 1989 and Sections 323, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 16.09.2014:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the ad-interim order dated 11.04.2014 passed by this Court on the application filed by Dilbagh Singh and others, co-accused of the petitioner.

Notice of motion to Advocate General, Punjab and respondent No.2 for 20.11.2014.

In the meantime, the petitioner shall surrender before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot on or

before 30.09.2014. In the event of his doing so, he be admitted to ad-interim bail by the said Court to its satisfaction.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance to the above order, petitioner has surrendered before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot and has furnished interim bail.

Accordingly, interim bail furnished by the petitioner in terms of the order dated 16.09.2014 before Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
