JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.56 dated 22.03.2014, under Sections 363, 365 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station City South Moga, District Moga.

As per the allegations, the petitioner while posing as a Nurse in the Hospital, lifted a new born boy from the custody of the complainant and handed it over to her mother-in-law Mukhtiar Kaur.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that main accused-Mukhtiar Kaur, from whom the recovery of child was made, has since been granted bail.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 28.03.2014 and after completion of investigation, challan is stated to have been presented.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from HC Rashpal Singh, concedes that the material witnesses have since been examined.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, keeping in view the facts as noticed above, this Court finds that petitioner/accused deserves the concession of regular bail and as such she is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Moga.
