This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.86 dated 18.08.2015 registered under Section 306 IPC, at Police Station Fattu Dyinga, District Kapurthala.

Reply filed by way of short affidavit of Piara Singh D.S.P. Sub Division, Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala is taken on record. Copy has been supplied.

After arguing for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not wish to press this petition on merits but liberty may be granted to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court

and move an application for regular bail and the trial Court may be directed to decide the said application expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair request. Let the petitioner surrender before the trial Court on or before 06.10.2015 and moves an application for regular bail which shall be decided expeditiously by the Court but in any case on or before 09.10.2015. It is made clear that in case the petitioner does not surrender before the Court in the aforesaid manner the present petition would be deemed to have been dismissed.

Petition stands dismissed as having been not pressed.
