JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners namely Jagdev Singh and Jagdeep Singh in FIR No.155 dated 26.7.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 452, 307, 323, 427, 148 & 149 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

As per allegations petitioner no.1 Jagdev Singh was armed with a hockey and petitioner no.2 Jagdeep Singh armed with a baseball bat and they have inflicted kick blows to complainant Darshan Singh.

It is contended that the FIR was lodged after 20 days of the occurrence and the main accused who is stated to have inflicted a *kirpan*

blow on the head has been granted the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Jaspal Singh submits that petitioners have joined investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/bail granted vide order dated 16th of September, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
