Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since during the pendency of the present petition, other offences under the NDPS Act have been added against the petitioner in this very FIR itself, he may be granted permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh one on the same cause of action, but with better particulars.

Permission is granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty as prayed for.

However, interim protection granted to the petitioner vide order dated 16.9.2015 shall continue to operate for another one week to enable the petitioner to file a fresh petition.
