JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.51 dated 22.05.2014, under Section 22 of the N.D.P.S. Act, registered with Police Station Fattu DHINGA, District Kapurthala, Punjab (**Annexure P-1**).

As per allegations in the FIR, recovery of 150 gms. of intoxicating powder was recovered when he was apprehended on 22.05.2014.

The petitioner has remained on interim bail w.e.f. 12.09.2014 till 30.01.2015 awaiting the chemical examiner's report.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from HC Sukhdev Singh, submits that the quantity recovered from the petitioner is commercial in nature and two prosecution witnesses out of eight have already been examined.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
