Learned State Counsel submits that cancellation report has been prepared and approved by the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana.

Since the cancellation report is being filed by the State, there is no reason for the investigating agency to arrest the petitioner and he should have no such apprehension.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no apprehension in the mind of the petitioner regarding arrest and the petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed accordingly.

An amount of Rs.2 lacs stands deposited, as stated, with the trial Court in compliance of the order dated 29.9.2014. In case the cancellation report is accepted by the Court, the amount shall be refunded to the petitioner.
